The application should be consulted and processed between designated staff members at home and host institutions, not on an individual basis. 2. Nominated students apply online (http://inter.kunsan.ac.kr/ap_0008.php) before the application deadline and upload the following documents at the same time: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Agreement for Using and Collecting Personal Information (Download at IALE website) 2) Official Transcript of home University 3) Current Enrollment Certificate of home University 4) Health Certificate 5) Copy of Passport & ID Card 6) Bank Deposit Certificate (USD3,700 for one Semester, USD7,300 for two Semesters) 7) Scanned Photo file 8) A letter of Recommendation from home university 9) Apostille or Consular confirmation at the Korean embassy in your country or the embassy of your country located in Korea. (Chinese applicants the College Scholastic Ability Test Records must be submitted as a certified report in English issued by CHSI) <p>※ NOTE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Please upload the scanned copy of all documents on the website by Oct. 31th, 2024. - No original hard copies of documents are needed - The applicant is requested to check all documents before uploading them. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3. After receiving admission letter, please visit the nearest Korean Embassy/Consulate to apply for a student visa (D-2-6) 4. Date of Registration: Oct. 31st, 2024

<p>Airport Pick-up</p>	<p>Airport Pickup Service</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Pick-up time(Scheduled): between 12pm-2pm on Mar. 3th, 2025 - Once you arrive at the airport, please find us between gate 12 and 13. - If student cannot make it on time, we will not be able to provide this service. In that case, student should come to KSNU by oneself. <p>How to get to the KSNU from the Airport?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - You can arrive in Gunsan from the Airport by bus. <p>Please buy the ticket and find 12B gate to take a bus. The gate can be found under the "Regional Province" sign.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - when you arrive at Gunsan Regional Province Terminal, take a taxi right across from the bus terminal for your convenience. It takes about 20 minutes and costs around KRW10,000. - Once you get off, please find IALE building and the office is located on the 3rd floor.
<p>Dormitory</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A double room at Student Dormitory is provided to exchange students (2 Students use a Room) - 3 Meals a day are provided (Meals are included to dormitory fee) ※ On weekends, only lunch and dinner are provided and they will be charged additionally. - Dormitory Fee : Approx. KRW1,300,000 per Semester
<p>Insurance</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Student who has applied for one semester exchange program is required to buy a private insurance in Korea or submit the copy of overseas travel insurance policy bought in home country. - Student who has applied for one year exchange program is required to buy NHI, the public health insurance in Korea from March 2021. (Monthly contribution to NHI is approx. KRW60,000)
<p>Korean Language Course</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Course Period: March 2025 to May 2025(Spring Semester) - Classes: Monday to Friday (4 hours a day, Total 200 hours) - Fee: KRW975,000 (25% off of the Original fee KRW1,300,000) - Text book: approx. KRW100,000
<p>Living Expenses</p>	<p>Minimum living expenses are estimated at about KRW300,000 per month for meals and Miscellaneous.</p>

- Levels: Basic (1, 2), Intermediate (1, 2), Advanced (1, 2)
- Grade Evaluation: Mid-term exam (40%), final exam (40%), attendance (10%), home work (10%)
- Mock-TOPIK at the end of every session
- Certificate of completion is issued only in case of 80% or higher attendance rate
